

Minutes EDAS committee meeting
February 15th at the Drayton Court Hotel

1. Apologies for absence - Martin
2. January minutes were approved
3. CE updated the committee that there were 391 people on the waiting list. CE showed the new clause to be inserted into the GC which permits the committee to move a member if necessary.
4. Site rental status- a plothead has said they are leaving . 2 half plots and GC on 147 are available.
5. Plot 209 – A solution is still being sought for the sweet chestnut plot. Deadline is the next committee meeting.
6. Allotment inspection date 27/28th April - two teams to preliminary inspect and then come together for actionable plots.
7. The Tin shed is considered unsafe and in need of a new roof, and new floor. Committee decided on buying a new shed to store the marquis and keep them dry. This will go on plot 209. The shed on 240 can then be demolished and the committee shed on 227 (old GClub) to move to 240.

9. Fruit garden – Committee to provide equipment and supplies to the volunteers.
